## Supporting Mental Health, *Together*

Dr. Wendy Stewart has been a pediatric neurologist at the Saint John Regional Hospital for 11 years and as such, frequently sees youth who are struggling, anxious and socially isolated.

Last spring, she received MindCare New Brunswick's Transformational Award, totaling over \$145,000 to support youth mental health and her work with the KV Oasis Youth Centre.

"I am very grateful to have received the Transformational and research grants," says Dr. Wendy Stewart, "as these funds will provide us with the opportunity to study the needs of youth in our community today, and the impact of the interventions and activities at KV Oasis Youth Centre."

The Centre aims to provide youth with the opportunity to develop relationships within their community that support their mental wellbeing. It provides access to counselling, workshops, as well as individual and group therapy sessions on various

mental health topics in a fun and safe environment.

In addition to the Transformational Award, she was also awarded a research grant to investigate the impact the centre has on youth mental health, providing the framework for establishing similar centres across New Brunswick.

## Determined to Fund a *Healthy Future for our Children*

### *The GIVE 2016 – Pediatrics Campaign Funded a 3-Year Social Pediatrics Research Coordinator*

You've heard the expression, *'you are what you eat'*. But have you also considered how your level of income, education, home environment, and access to health and social services can affect your health? Living conditions such as these are known as the social determinants of health, and they play an essential role in shaping the health of our families and communities.

*1 in 5 New Brunswick children and youth live in poverty.* It's numbers like these that brought Dr. Sarah Gander, Dr. Marianne McKenna, and Dr. Annie Murphy Savoie together with research coordinator Sarah Campbell to establish the New Brunswick Social Pediatrics Research Program. They're currently designing and carrying out a clinical research initiative aimed at uncovering how the social determinants of health impact our most vulnerable children in our community. Their research will help shape local and regional health policy and practices, and will positively impact the quality of life and health outcomes of children and families.

Early in the project, their review of data on pediatric referrals for behavioral issues showed more than half of referrals are for children from the lowest income neighbourhoods. Initiatives going forward include numerous studies on how to improve access and navigation in the care of children with complex psychosocial needs. In particular, the newly funded Parent Child Assistance Program will help mothers with drug and alcohol use during pregnancy and their exposed infants. In just 6 months, the *NB Social Pediatrics Research Program* has secured over a million dollars in funding, and is still developing new ideas and initiatives to help address the numerous challenges faced by our families.

*Work like this takes time, dedication, and money if it's to be successful. We're committed to helping fund transformational projects like this, and with the support of your generous donations, we'll help ensure our researchers can continue their quest to help protect our community's most vulnerable children.*

## Funding *Life-Saving Equipment*

The Saint John Regional Hospital Foundation's support has enabled us to purchase our SIM mannequin. We've since been able to grow our Mobile Simulation Unit program and deliver hands on education across New Brunswick.

In the past year alone, the Mobile Simulation Unit has been able to deliver over 15 courses to multidisciplinary trauma teams all over the province in both French and English. A fundamental component of SIM is that we travel to each site allowing the trauma team there to practice high intensity clinical situations in their own environment; it's important to know that in an emergency situation, not only does the team need to know what they're doing, but also be rehearsed in how to do it in their specific environment. This is especially important for rural centres that may not see major traumas as

often. For patients, this means that if they are unfortunate enough to become seriously or critically injured, no matter where they live, they know that their clinical team is practiced and confident in how to manage their injuries.

*The generous support from the Foundation has allowed us to support our trauma teams, which ensures exceptional, equitable care everywhere in our province.*

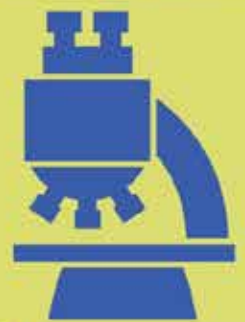

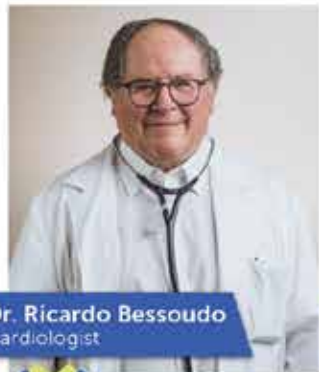
