After the challenges the world has faced in the last two years, we all know how vital our mission is and how important it is to support health care workers. Thank you for helping us create a healthier future together.



TRANSFORMATIONAL GIVING \$526,841

Your generosity supported the creation of Atlantic Canada's first Imaging Enhancement Centre.



New Imaging Enhancement Centre

You enabled us to extend more critically important care into the community by transforming medical imaging. Horizon's Saint John Regional Hospital will house a 3-D printer that will allow clinicians to create a virtual copy of their patient's anatomy to plan and practice surgery. The Imaging Enhancement Centre, the first in Atlantic Canada, will have the potential to be a regional centre of excellence and may even emerge as a national or international leader. The technology will be available to surgeons and teams across the province. The Imaging Enhancement Centre will also be the first in Canada to adopt Subtle Medical's AI Solutions, SubtlePETTM.

The cutting-edge of medical innovation increasingly shifts towards digitization. The 3-D Imaging Centre, the first in Atlantic Canada, will have the potential to be a regional centre of excellence and may even emerge as a national or international leader.

ADVANCING CANCER CARE \$394,002

Because of you, we acquired the latest technology, supporting cancer patients in our community.



Enhanced Treatment and Care for Lung Cancer Patients

Donor generosity helped fund new state-of-the-art technologies, including a 3-D Bronchoscopic Navigation System to find smaller, more distal tumours and Fluorescence Imaging technology to show where the cancer is to spare healthy lung tissues. Clinicians can now reduce the time from identifying lung cancer to definitive treatment and provide immediate enhancement to the care provided.

Automated DNA/RNA Extractor

With your support, the Foundation purchased a DNA-RNA extractor to automate the preparation of both DNA and RNA from solid tumour blood and bone marrow samples, allowing geneticists to develop more targeted treatments for cancer patients.

Enhanced Drug Monitoring

Your gifts allowed us to fund the purchase of a Tandem Mass Spectrometer, the gold standard for the rapeutic drug monitoring and testing. This vital technology allows the lab at Horizon's Saint John Regional Hospital to provide a definitive and comprehensive analysis of illicit and therapeutic drugs for various clinical purposes with a 24-hour turnaround time, significantly improving the current care model. The new technology will enable clinicians to incorporate results more quickly into effective clinical decision-making, including the potential to prevent overdoses and improve patient safety.

Epic Ultrasound System

Technology used by Cardiac OR and Interventional Cardiology to guide the procedure and to determine the success of interventions in real time allowing for adjustments when needed.

Cardiohelp Portable Bypass System

Portable Extracorporeal Membrane Oxygenation (ECMO) system, compact and light-weight technology which can be rapidly deployed making it ideal for transporting patients while on circulatory and /or pulmonary support.

Four new generation myocardial protection pumps required for all open-heart surgeries.

Six Point of Care Ultrasound Units, enabling the next generation of physicians at the Dalhousie Medicine New Brunswick Campus to gain practice scanning independently.

Enhancing Care with Simulation Training

- Neonatal Simulation Manikin to facilitate the training of health care professionals to initiate proper care and resuscitation of preterm infants.
- Child Birth Simulator, allowing medical teams to become efficient in responding to childbirth emergencies protecting mother and baby.
- Vimedix High Fidelity Ultrasound Simulator to support the Emergency Department Point of Care Ultrasound System (PoCUS) Education Program.
- Cardiac Ultrasound Simulator, Transesophageal echocardiography (TEE) produces clear pictures of the heart and its structures, allowing training physicians to look more closely at a patient's heart to see if it may be producing blood clots.
